Summary of Recent Chapter Reports

2024 (most recent reporting cycle) - 12 reports were submitted

- 8 Chapters submitted full reports (China, Brazil, Germany, BeNeLux, Iran, France, Mexico, UK)
- 4 Chapters submitted light reports (WAIC, Japan, Spain, Australia)

2023 – 15 reports were submitted

- 4 Chapters submitted full reports (Brazil, China, France, Germany)
- 11 Chapters submitted light reports (Spain, Australia, BeNeLux, Iran, Israel, Japan, Mexico, NE-MW US, Norway, Saudi Arabia, WAIC)

3) Steps which can be taken to improve the engagement of National Chapters and the creation of new National Chapters

- * Expectation setting around the demands of running a National Chapter (see Guidelines for NCC tasks)
 - -- NCC can invite temporary members for the creation of chapters as well as for helping support for any of the above activities.
 - -- NCC can invite temporary members for help National Chapters
 - -- Discuss which leadership renovations across National Chapters might be necessary
- -- Augment the number of the members of the NCC (see Guidelines for NCC tasks). The National Chapter Committee (NCC) is composed of a chair, a vice-chair, and up to 6 additional members, plus a Secretary. All NCC members will be appointed by the InterPore Executive Committee, for a two-years term (renewable once).
